How much did He know? (Luke 2:41 – 52; Key verse - 49)

"And he said unto them, How is it that ye sought me? <u>wist</u> ye not that I must be about my Father's business?" (Pluperfect tense – once and for all in time past) (to know – oida)

Intro: This should prove to be interesting in and of itself. Perhaps you have or may be not, asked or wondered, "when did Jesus ______ He was the Son of God?" And of course, this also begs the question concerning what might have Jesus' childhood been like? Was He a typical child? Was He an obedient child? Could He have been a prankish child? Interestingly enough the Bible is relatively silent on the early days of His childhood until He begins to approach that age in which Jewish boys are becoming men. This that time around thirteen years of age for boys and girls when they are considered to enter adulthood. They have been instructed in the Jewish Law and are ready to take on the responsibility of following the Jewish Law.
