

Of Offerings & Sacrifices – Part II  
(Leviticus 5:4 6)

I. The Trespass Offering.

- A. Having briefly looked at the ‘sacrifice for ignorance’ which represented the problem of man’s sin \_\_\_\_\_, we look at the ‘trespass offering’ which deals with a \_\_\_\_\_ sin.
- B. This offering was an \_\_\_\_\_ of guilt concerning a particular sin the individual committed.
- C. This offering would coincide to a person who is \_\_\_\_\_ and are aware of this fact.
1. This person is aware that they have sinned and \_\_\_\_\_ they have done wrong.
  2. **Romans 7:7** – “What shall we say then? *Is the law sin? God forbid. Nay, I had not known sin, but by the law: for I had not known lust, except the law had said, Thou shalt not covet.”*
  3. Because of the written Law, that which constitutes sin is \_\_\_\_\_ and readily knowable.
  4. **Joshua 22:20** – “Did not Achan the son of Zerah commit a trespass in the accursed thing, and wrath fell on all the congregation of Israel? and that man perished not alone in his iniquity.
    - a. We can never in all honesty say that what we do is our \_\_\_\_\_ business, or that it doesn’t affect others.
    - b. **Galatians 5:4 – 8.**
    - c. There was the impact on \_\_\_\_\_ family – **Johua 7:11, 16 – 26.** We have or need to realize that God sees sin from a different perspective then we do!
    - d. **I Corinthians 5: - 6,** the impact on the \_\_\_\_\_ testimony.
  5. Some are sure to think the punishment was rather \_\_\_\_\_ or severe but sin when it is conceived brings forth death – **James 1:15.**
    - a. If God is going to do and accomplish great things, He needs a people \_\_\_\_ whom He is able to work in and through.
    - b. Whether it is for His name’s sake or even for our sake concerning His plans for us.
    - c. There is a very important lesson to be learned here for the ages concerning our relationship with God, and what He wants to accomplish and what is \_\_\_\_\_ for those accomplishments to take place.

- d. Israel is about to cross over Jordan to fight a war they cannot win unless God brings the victory, and God's needs the people to be spiritually \_\_\_\_\_.
6. \_\_\_\_\_ in His mercy has chosen a means by which we can make things right when we have chosen to transgress and deliberately sin against Him.
- D. Symbolically, this trespass offering pictures Jesus Christ dying to remove the guilt of sin.
1. Guilt is a \_\_\_\_\_ that can remain long after the sin has been forgiven –  
**Ephesians 5:25 – 27.**
  2. The purpose of the trespass offering was to \_\_\_\_\_ one's guilt and the death of Christ on the cross does the same thing.
    - a. **Hebrews 9:8 – 1.** The Old Testament sacrifices only covered the present trespass with the forward look to when Christ would fulfill all things.
    - b. I John 1:9.
