Question: What is the difference between our spirit, and our soul?

## In His Image (I Thessalonians 5:16 – 28; Key verse is verse 23)

Intro: The first two study blanks are on the rail outside the sanctuary if you need them to
complete this topic of today. In this passage we find that most of the verbs are, present tense,
active voice and in the imperative mood. Which for the most part means these are actions
meant to be taken seriously and worked out in the daily operation of the Believer's life.
Indeed, as verse 23 states that we are "made in the image of God," then our text is a text
revealing things that exist in God's and if we are made in His image, then they
should be taking place in our lives as well. It is called "spiritual growth." We are a try-partite
being,
1. We have a – it is either dead to God or alive unto God. <mark>(Pneuma)</mark>
2. We have a – it is where reasoning, thought & emotions take place. (Psuche)
3. We have a $\_\_\_$ body – This is the part that senses the world around us. (Soma)
4. <mark>I Corinthians 2:14 – 3:3</mark> .
To understand how each of these parts function in relation to each other, it is easier to grasp
if we look at each as
We move to the third layer (container) of our being, the 'Pneuma' or the spirit of man. This
area is where God-consciousness is received and processed, meant to be an influence in our
mind where the issues of morality are processed and is as well eternal. The body will die and
be buried and is physically mortal while the spirit eternal as is the soul of man. When we die
our soul and spirit lives on into eternity in one of two places, hell and or heaven depending on
the decision we make about Jesus Christ. Reject Him and one's soul and spirit will go out into
a Christ-less eternity of torment and darkness, while if one chooses to accept Christ as Savior
our soul and spirit will spend eternity with Christ. Luke 16:19 – 31 bears witness to this.
III. The Pneuma – the spirit of man – I Thessalonians 5:23.
A. The important truth here is that all human's have a body, a soul and a spirit.

1. The body has a direct \_\_\_\_\_ with the world and provides us with information.

2. Every human is born with a spirit \_\_\_\_\_ from God or unable to receive from God

the information God has for living our lives unto Him. (I Corinthians 2:14 – 16.)

c. When we come to a saving faith in Christ, our soul and spirit are	_
( <mark>John 6:63</mark> – quickened meaning to give life – <mark>I Corinthians 2:15 &amp; 16.)</mark>	
d. If we look at I Corinthians $3:1-3$ we see that when we will not take the time	e to
read, study & meditate in the Word of God, man's spirit remains	_
by the flesh and ignores the Holy Spirit of God endeavoring to conform us to	
the image of Christ – <mark>Romans 8:26 – 29.</mark>	
3. Twice in the previous passage we are the ministry of the Holy Spirit of God,	, in
the life of the Redeemed, is able to interact with our spirit because our spirit has be	een
quickened the second we accepted Christ as our Savior — also - Colossians 2:13.	
B. With our quickened spirit the Holy Spirit to our spirit which is now	
able to relate to godliness and as we mature, to even desire to live to please God.	
1. Ephesians 2:1. The point is, now there is a to God and spiritual tru	th
that did not exist, nor could it have existed prior to one's salvation. Things now be	gin
to make sense to us – <mark>II Corinthians 5:17 – 23 &amp; 5:9 &amp; 10.</mark>	
2. When Adam sinned in the Garden of Eden, the spirit of man did and in time m	nan
would die a physical death, the body went into the ground, the soul and spirit into	
eternity to face God – Romans 14:12; I Peter 4:5 & Daniel 12:1 – 3.	
3. If John 16:7 – 15 could never take place in our lives if our spirit is not	
thereby enabling the Holy Spirit to lead us into all truth.	
C. What God is after in our lives, is spirit controlled, a mind-controlled, th	at
begins with the influence and tutoring by the Holy Spirit of God, using the infallibly	
preserved Word of God., to our spirit, then from our spirit to the mind, with the	
expectation that our mind will mature and reign over our bodies – Romans 6:12.	
D. Jesus touched on this when He was speaking to the Samaritan woman at the well in	
John 4:2 – 26, <u>note verses 22 – 24</u> .	
1. Here is a solid reason why works can never, ever save anyone.	
2. Works are things we do physically and usually according to our own desires.	
3. Perhaps some ecclesiastical orders errantly may have physical works for penance.	
4. The for worshipping God is the spirit of man that has been quickened by the	e
power of God when as sinners we come to a saving faith in Christ.
