## A Servant of The Lord – Part II

**Introduction:** We have been looking at Revelation 1:9 & 10 and discovering what makes for a quality Servant. And so the theme of these two lessons is obviously “quality”. Not as man defines the idea of quality, but how God both defines the word and then give us prime examples how we can be quality servants as well.

### III. A He knows God is in \_\_\_\_\_ – (Kingdom) Revelation 1:9.

A. We are living in His kingdom, seen and unseen, where God has \_\_\_\_\_ forever.

1. The seen is our physical world which exists within God’s kingdom.

2. The unseen presently is where God’s throne exist I n heaven.

a. It is the place \_\_\_\_\_ was caught-up in the spirit and visited, Isaiah 6:1-8.

b. It was the place \_\_\_\_\_ while being stoned to death saw – Acts 7:53 – 8:1.

B. God is in control of everything, and He knows everything as \_\_\_\_\_ escapes Him.

1. He knows how many beats our heart has or breathes we will breathe – Hebrews 9:27-28.

2. He knows the corruption that exists behind this pandemic and any event.

3. He knows who the anti-Christ is, where he is and when he’ll show up.

4. There is absolutely nothing about us/anyone that He doesn’t know all about them.

a. Jeremiah 1:1-10.    b. Psalm 139:1-24.    c. Isaiah 49:5.    D. Romans 8:29.

### IV. He knows God is in no \_\_\_\_\_ – (Patience) – Revelation 1:9.

A. \_\_\_\_\_ is just one of those things we don’t do very well.

B. We know God can do anything, we just don’t \_\_\_\_\_ if He will.

1. Daniel 3:16.

2. They were adamant about what God can/could do, but they were not sure He would!

C. Patience is waiting on God to do or not to do what we know He can do.

1. Isaiah 40:31.

2. Psalm 37:9

3. Hebrews 11:8 – 13.

### V. He knows his life has \_\_\_\_\_ – (Word) Revelation 1:9.

A. God \_\_\_\_\_ John to the Isle of Patmos from the main land for a purpose. Why?

1. As the verse says, it was for the “Word of God.”

2. We have to understand that God always has a \_\_\_\_\_ for the why, the where, and the how for us.

a. It may be to correct or redirect our lives.

b. It may be to reach someone with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

c. The point is we need to be \_\_\_\_\_ to the Holy Spirit’s leadership in our lives.

d. We need to stop questioning God as if He is \_\_\_\_\_ us, (Jeremiah 18:3 – 6).

4. It means God has \_\_\_\_\_ out all of human history before the foundations of the earth – Acts 15:18.
5. This includes John's life and our lives as well.
6. Why did Christ have to die? Matthew 26:54 & 56; Mark 14:49. **Acts 2:23; Luke 22:22.**

C. John had a divine purpose with in God's plan, and so do you and I

1. We need to make sure our lives are \_\_\_\_\_ and available for Him.
2. John had an angel give Him his purpose for Patmos.
3. We may have to wait until heaven to find out some of the whys.
4. Abraham had a divine purpose. (Genesis 12:1 – 3)
5. Joseph had a purpose. (Genesis 50:19 – 21)
6. John the Baptist had a purpose, a voice in the wilderness – Matthew 3:3.
7. Blind Bartimaeus had a purpose – Mark 10:46 – 52
8. The blind man in John 9 had a purpose – John 9:1 – 5.

## **VI. He knows how to \_\_\_\_\_ the Lord – (Spirit) Revelation 1:10.**

A. Being in the spirit (Romans 8:8) means being saved and surrendered in every area of one's life.

1. Doesn't mean we are perfect, but it does mean we want to be perfect.
2. Doesn't mean we won't mess up, but that we are confessed up & prayed up. – I John 1:9.

B. When you awoke today, you had to make some \_\_\_\_\_.

1. Today, I am going to walk in the flesh which requires you do nothing.
2. Today, I am going to walk in the Spirit, going to meet with God, let go of my life and give it to Him.
3. I am going to get right, stay right, pray and have devotions.
4. regardless of where I am or what I am doing, I can please God – folks it is a choice!
  - a. Serving God & making one's self available is a choice.
  - b. Happiness is a choice that stems from one's choosing to rejoice in the Lord.
